# What To Look For:

- Size:
  - —Tall
  - -Lengthy
  - -Large body capacity
  - -Good spring of ribs
  - -Wide at pin bones



# What To Look For:

- Dairy Character
  - -Walking upwards
  - -Trim and feminine head and neck
  - -Angular over hips, withers, pins
  - Carrying minimal extra fat
  - -Level from hips to pins



# What To Look For:


- Udder:
  - -Smooth fore udder attachment
  - -High and wide rear udder attachment
  - Evenly divided udder quarters
  - Desirable sized and shaped teats
  - -Carried above hocks

## How to Give Reasons:

- Taking Notes-
  - Divide page into four sections
  - Write down all distinguishing characteristics
  - Take notes as you judge class
  - Take note of good and bad things for each cow

Straight top line	Hígh/wíde rear udder attachment
Large body capacity	Shorter than 1
Best udder	Level from hips to pins
Cow 3- One horn Good spring of rib Weak fore udder attachment Poor dairy character	Cow 4- Smallest cow Weak pasterns Good daíry character Has brown halter


